



Society Questions ↔ Society Quotient

Purpose:

This activity focuses on orienting and re-orienting members regarding aspects of the Society – Name, Insignia, Symbols, Purposes, Mission Statement, Membership, Finances, Organization, Executive Board, Committees, Areas of Activity, Funds, Amendments, Foundation, and Documents

Materials:

Master Set of SQ Questions and Answers for presenter, 1 set of Question Cards, 1 set of Answer Cards (Question cards should be a different color from Answer Cards.)

Instructions:

Distribute question cards to members.

Presenter selects from the master list an answer and reads the category and answer. The presenter may randomly select the categories and answers, or she may focus on a particular category. After the category and answer are given, the member having the card with the correct question asks the next Society Question.

Or

Distribute answer cards with to members.

Presenter selects from the master list a question and reads the category and question. The presenter may randomly select the categories and questions or she may focus on a particular category. After the category and question are given, the member with the correct answer, reads the answer for the Society Question.

Member SQ:

A member can discover her own SQ (Society Quotient) by keeping track of the number of items she knows out of the total number of items presented.

Other Uses:

This material could also be presented in a Jeopardy format or used as a card game where members attempt to accumulate sets of matching questions and answers.

Activity for Learning *The Delta Kappa Gamma Song*

Materials:

One complete collection of the song graphics, one picture to a page, in four sets, one for each verse of the song.

Activity:

1. Divide those present into four groups.
2. Distribute one set of graphics to each group; each group's graphics are different.
3. Each group's task is to put the pictures in the correct order, matching each graphic to the appropriate words in the song.
4. The result for each group is that group members can sing their portion of the song correctly highlighting the appropriate graphics.
5. Finally, the entire group joins to sing the song from beginning to end; when each graphic is appropriate, it is raised for all to see.
